



Sea Snakes

Sea snakes mostly live in the Pacific Islands. Most have black and white stripes. Sea snakes weave through the water. They trick the eyes.

Sea snake heads and tails are black. Predators can't tell what direction it's going. Predators can't tell where the snake's head is. They think the snake is attacking from behind. This gives the snake time. It can swim away. Or it can fight.

Sea snakes are venomous. The venom can kill a person in 15 minutes to 24 hours.



There are very few animals in the sea brave enough to take on a sea snake.
