Move 2:

The Kraken slowly rises to the top. It covers its nose and mouth with a tentacle. It protects itself from the Hydra's poisonous breath and smell.

Move 3:

The Hydra sees one of the Kraken's tentacles. Its main head breathes out fire. The Kraken's tentacle gets burned off.

Move 4:

The Kraken begins the process of regrowing its tentacle.

Another tentacle grabs one of the Hydra's heads. Its
suckers squeeze the head off.

But some of the Hydra's blood

gets on the Kraken. The Kraken guickly bites off its own tentacle. It does this so the poison won't spread.

In some stories, heroes dip weapons in the Hydra's blood.

Kraken: Since the Kraken lives in the sea, it mainly eats fish. The Kraken eats a lot of fish. It can eat all kinds of fish and sea

creatures. Its beak is able to break through hard shells. It can swallow some fish whole. It also eats sailors who fall into the ocean.

Hydra: The Hydra likes to eat human flesh. The Hydra wasn't born eating humans. But once it tasted human meat, that's all it would eat. The Hydra adapted to its living space. Its food sources are fish and sailors. Sailors are easier to hunt in the water. They can't swim or run away. The Hydra needs to eat fish as well. Humans aren't that nutritious. They don't provide enough energy.
