

Activities for Inside and Outside

Lesson 2

Activity 1- Color the Object

Items needed: crayons

Picture needed: *Inside and Outside #2*

Instructions: Ask the student to color the nouns using the colors specified below.

1. Use a purple crayon to color the ears on the mouse that is outside the circle.
2. Use an orange crayon to color the ears on the mouse that is inside the circle.
3. Use a red crayon to color the apple that is outside the hole.
4. Use a blue crayon to color the apple that is inside the hole.
5. Use a green crayon to color the marbles that are outside the jar.
6. Use a yellow crayon to color the marbles that are inside the jar.

Ask the student to identify the location of each noun in the picture. Point to each noun and ask, "Where is this _____?" (e.g., "Where is this mouse?"). The student should be reinforced for using **inside** and **outside** correctly.

Activity 2- Memory Challenge

Items needed: box, cup, paper clip, pencil, penny

Instructions: Ask the student to complete the following tasks.

1. Wiggle your fingers, then put your hand inside the box.
2. Put your hand outside the cup, then put the pencil in the box.
3. Put the penny outside the cup, jump three times, then clap your hands.
4. Put the paper clip inside the cup, then put the penny inside the box.
5. Put the cup inside the box, then put the pencil outside the cup.
6. Touch your nose, put your hand inside a cup, then touch your ear.

Activity 3- Draw a Picture

Picture needed: *Inside and Outside #3*

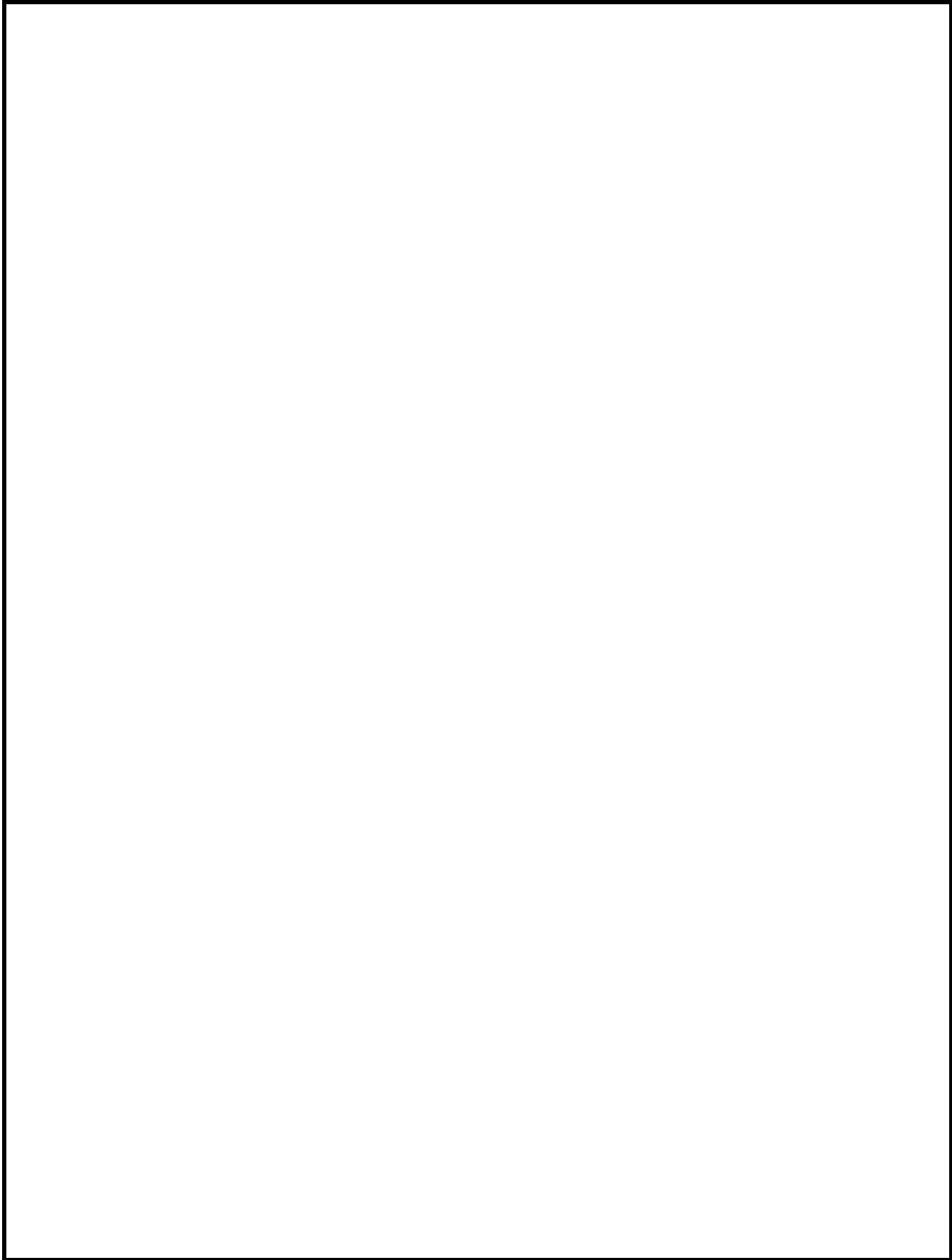
Instructions: Ask the student to draw nouns **inside** and **outside** the boxes and circles on this page.

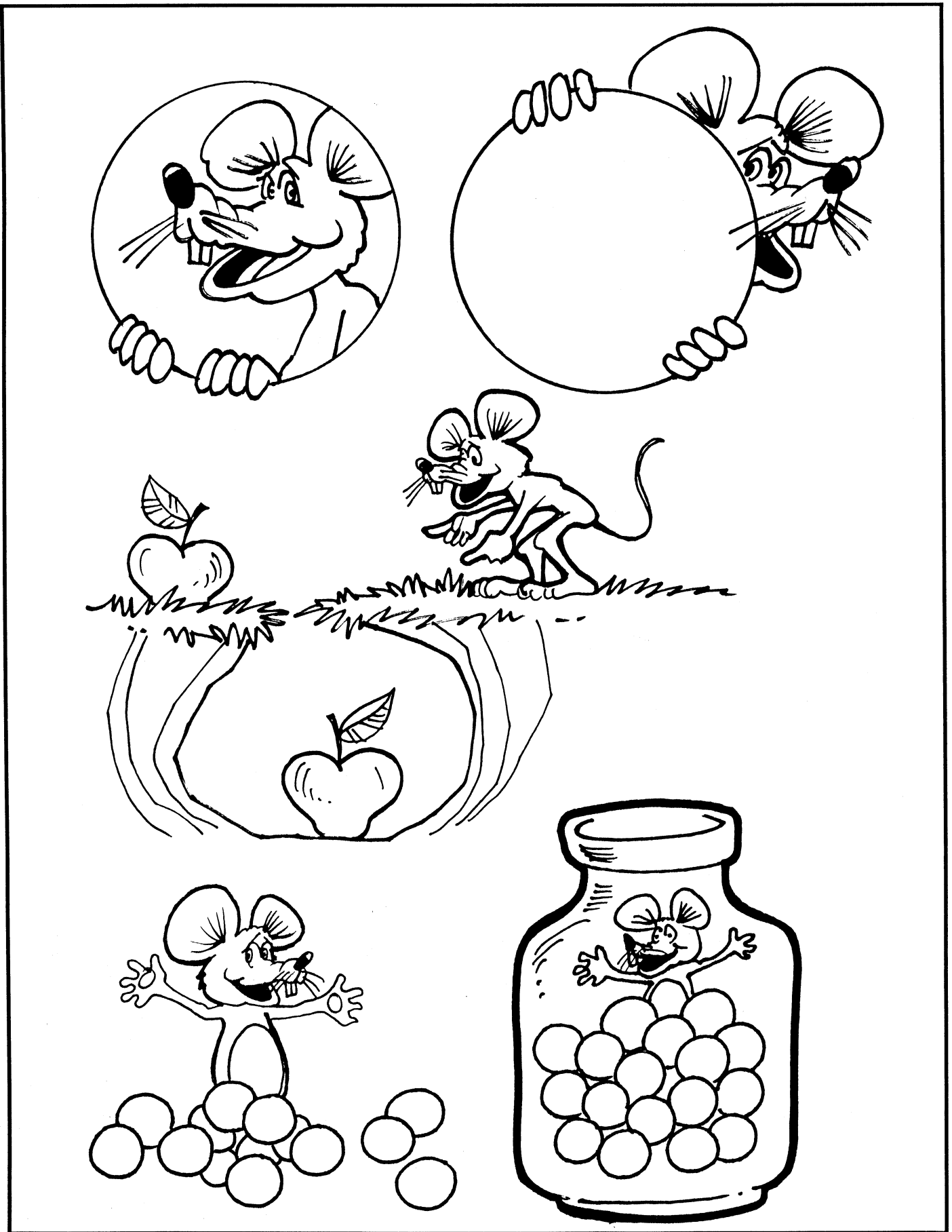
1. Draw a shoe outside the big box.
2. Draw a hat inside the small box.
3. Draw a shirt inside the big circle.
4. Draw a hand outside the small circle.

Activity 4- Make a Sentence

Pictures needed: *Inside and Outside #4 through #6*

Instructions: Ask the student to describe each picture in a complete sentence using **inside** and **outside**. Have the student take these pictures home for additional practice and reinforcement.
