Introduction

Multiple Meanings Photo Super Fun Deck® has 100 pairs of photo cards to help students learn how to use multiple meaning words in sentences. The *Super Fun Deck*® is divided into four color-coded levels, with 25 pairs in each level: Grades **K-2**, **3-5**, **6-8**, and **9-12**. Pairs are great for playing games like Go Fish, Memory, or Match-up. Additional game ideas follow.

Game Ideas



Round Table – Divide cards into matching A/B pairs. Therapist picks a card and reads aloud. ("Buddy the **Bear** has a favorite spot in the woods to think.") Each player in turn makes up a sentence using the target word. ("We saw a **bear** while we were camping.") Award a point for correct responses. Therapist then reads matching card aloud. Players make up new sentences. Player with the most points wins.

Do You Mean It? – Shuffle cards and place deck facedown. First player picks up a card and says it aloud. ("Olivia sat next to the outlet so she could **charge** her phone.") Player then makes up a sentence using the target multiple meaning word in a different way. ("I am in **charge** of watering the plants tonight.") Player keeps card or receives a point if answer is correct, or puts card on bottom of deck if incorrect. Play continues in turn. Player with the most cards/points at end of game wins.

Hustle! – Therapist decides how many matching pairs each player will get. Shuffle pairs and place facedown in front of each player. (Ex. 10 cards/5 matches in front of each player.) Dealer says "Hustle." Each player then turns over his/her cards and begins making matches. First player to finish making his/her matches wins. Each player then says his/her matches aloud in turn.
