un-	not	un + tied = untied (not tied)	Her shoe was untied.
dis-	not	dis + like = dislike (not to like)	I dislike spicy food.
re-	again	re + order = reorder (to order again)	He will reorder his hamburger without onions.
mis-	badly, wrong, false	mis + spell = misspell (spell badly)	Did you misspell the name?

Prefix	Means	Example	Sentence
inter-	between, among	inter + personal = interpersonal (between persons)	He has great interpersonal skills.
non-	not	non + sense = nonsense (not sense)	I didn't understand all that nonsense.
pre-	before	pre + paid = prepaid (paid before)	Dad prepaid for the pizza.
sub-	below, down	sub + heading = subheading (a heading below)	The subheading was below the picture.
un-	not	un + tied = untied (not tied)	Her shoe was untied.
re-	again	re + order = reorder (to order again)	He will reorder his hamburger without onions.
