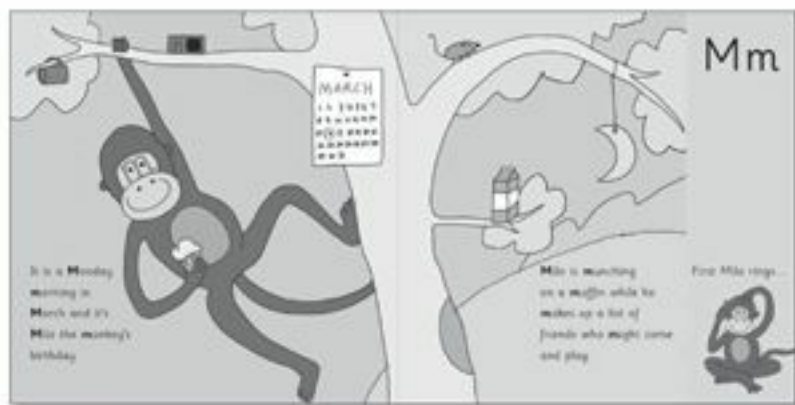


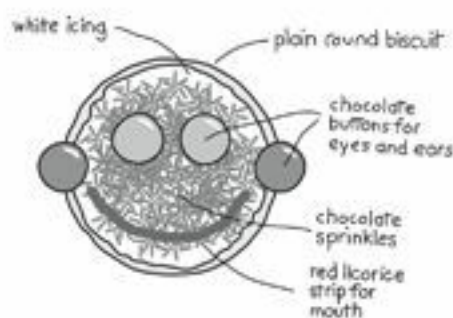
# Milo the monkey



## You will need

- Milo's Music CD
  - 'Little Learners Love Literacy' song
  - 'Milo the monkey' song
- Little Learners Love Literacy box and objects or pictures to go inside beginning with the sound /m/. For example:
 

mouse	mug	money	muffin	magnet
marshmallow	monkey	map	maracas	mirror
mushroom	mandarin	motorbike		
- Milo's Alphabet Games flashcards for **m**
- Small mirrors (one for each child, if possible)
- Copies of Milo the monkey art and craft sheet (see CD) plus:
  - strips of coloured paper
  - felt-tip pens or coloured pencils
  - goggle eyes
- Copies of the handwriting sheet for the letter **m** (see CD)
- Coloured pencils or felt-tip pens
- Words to use during the session: marvellous, magic, magnificent, mighty
- Cooking activity ingredients, for each child:
  - a plain round biscuit
  - icing
  - chocolate sprinkles
  - chocolate buttons (for eyes and ears)
  - a red licorice strip (for mouth)
  - plus a sample of Milo's biscuit
- Milo's Birthday Surprise Alphabet Frieze
- Maraca for phonemic fun



## Warm up

Say: *It's time to wake up our bodies. Let's wake up our heads.*

With children, pat your head and chant 'Wake up head, wake up head'.

Why do we need to wake up our head?

Extend the warm-up activity with other body parts.
